

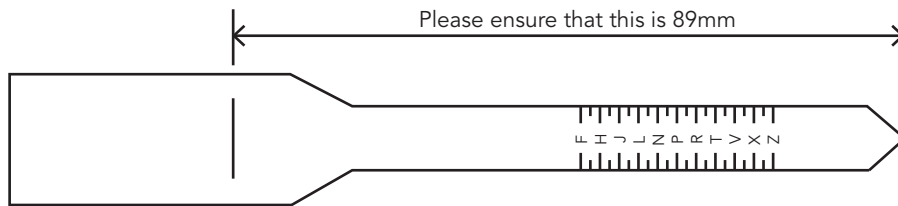
FIND YOUR RING SIZE

CONFIRM PRINTED SCALE

1. Prior to printing, ensure that page scaling is set to 'none', '100%' or 'actual size' in the print dialog box.
2. Ensure the Ring Sizing Guide is printed on Standard A4-size paper for the best accuracy.
3. The ring sizer on this document should be 89mm long. Please refer to the diagram below for more information.

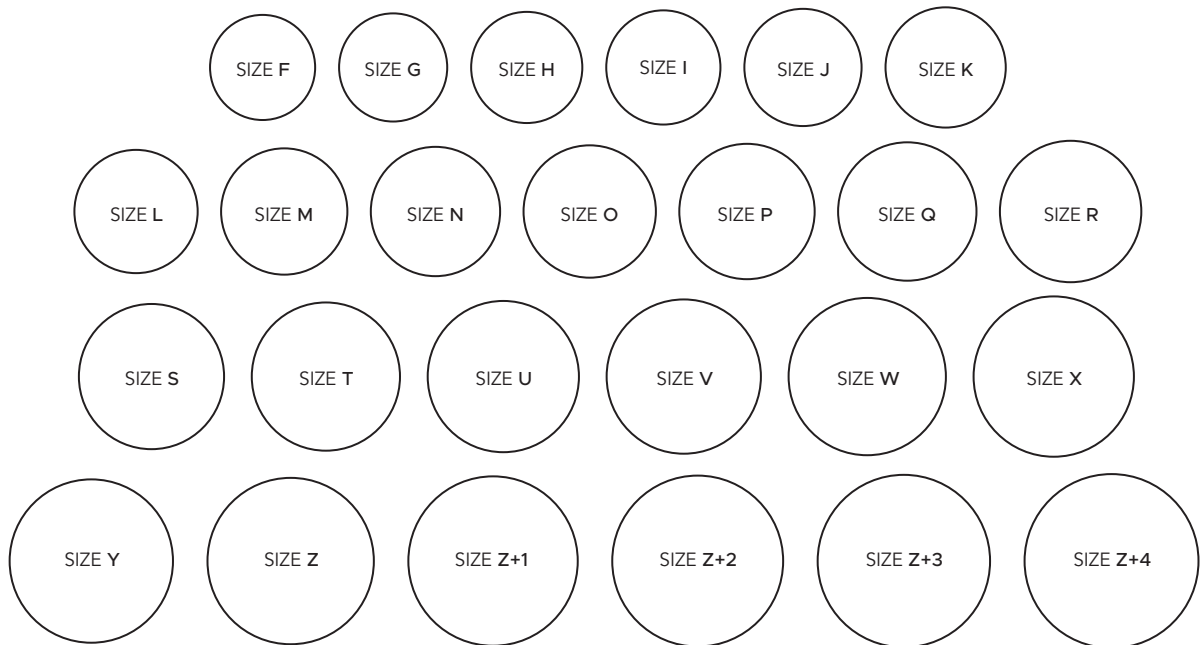
OPTION 1: MEASURE YOUR FINGER

1. Print and cut out the marked ring sizer as shown below.
2. Wrap the ring sizer around the ring finger with the marked side visible to you.
3. Note down the letter that is the closest to the slit on the fatter end - that is your ring size.



OPTION 2: MEASURE CURRENT RING

1. Print the Ring Sizing Guide.
2. Select a ring that fits the intended finger properly.
3. Place the ring over the circles until the inside of the ring matches a specific circle.
4. If your ring happens to fall between two sizes, order the larger one.

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TIPS FOR MEASURING RING SIZE

Ring sizing tips

A perfect ring should be comfortable on the wearer. The ring should be loose enough that it glides on and off the finger comfortably but it should be snug when it pushes over the knuckle to ensure it will not slide off.

Band thickness

If you select a ring with a wider band you should order a half size bigger than your measurement to allow for the extra band width.

Temperature

Please ensure you measure your finger multiple times to ascertain the correct size as finger size changes depending on the time of day and the weather.

Fingers are largest first thing in the morning and in warm weather.

Cold weather causes fingers to shrink so please keep this in mind when determining your size. The best time is mid afternoon when you are at room temperature.

Is it a surprise?

Ask your significant other's friends or family if they know her finger size.

Borrow one of her rings (from the correct finger) and use our ring measurements above to determine the correct ring size.

Methods

We do not recommend using the String method to measure ring size, string can be tricky to keep taut and can result in the wrong reading. If you have large knuckles, measure both your knuckle and the base of the finger and select a size which falls between the two. The best ring to use with our printable ring sizing chart is a plain, narrow band. Rings with large stones set may give a distorted reading due to the settings lifting the ring shank off the page.

Popular ring sizes/ International Conversion

If the ring is for a gift, as a rough guide a K 1/2 is a 'Small' M 1/2 is a 'Medium' and P 1/2 is a 'Large' presuming the ring is for a ring finger.

Our most popular size for females is a size L 1/2. The most popular size for males is an R.
